We are excited to introduce our first Bulletin Board Forums for GED Teachers and Administrators. In order to access the online Bulletin Boards , as well as any converted web-based training modules, you must first [create your Moodle profile.](#)

When you first access the Moodle program, you will be prompted with either signing in to your Moodle account OR creating your Moodle profile.

In any event, the page should look something like this:
